

Original farm buildings with a delightfully golden patina are home to 17 rooms, a pool, serve-yourself bar, snug and all-day kitchen. Bikes and buggies provide ample opportunity for getting over to the gardens, and the spa and house at Hadspen.





SPACES

Within the Farmyard are places to relax and unwind. The Garner Bar is available all day for serve-yourself drinks, with chef's home-made cake offering the perfect pick-me-up in the afternoon. Cosy up in the Snug. Watch movies on the big screen, play games or host as you wish. Jump in the pool and spend some restorative time in the Vitality Pool. Gather at Farmyard Kitchen for feelgood wood-fired fare, fresh from the open kitchen.



RESTAURANT

Experience creative dishes worth sharing at Farmyard Kitchen. Located in an old Threshing Barn at the beating heart of Farmyard, Chef Allan Altschul and team serve hearty, cheering fare using ingredients grown, foraged and reared on the estate.

BEDROOMS

Once agricultural buildings, now 17 rooms to rest your head, with en suite bathrooms, charming original features and hidden nooks. In the original farmhouse, Farmhouse Rooms evoke a quiet elegance with marble bathrooms and original fireplaces. Pastoral views bring you back down to earth. Some of our stylish rooms feature personal steam pods. Up in the eaves you'll find space to breathe with our two loftiest suites, The Stalls and Apple Loft.



EXPLORE THE ESTATE


While not exclusive, you can take in the rest of the estate on buggies, two feet or two wheels.

SPA

Housed where the cow barns once stood, the Spa offers international treatments with an English country feel. Focusing on natural ingredients and wellness therapies using scents derived from an English garden, the Spa includes a herb garden, swimming pool, indoor-outdoor hydro pool, sauna, steam room, halotherapy room, authentic Hammam, mud rasul chamber and seven treatment rooms. The Gym and Yoga Studio are a skip away, through the pick-your-own kitchen garden.






GARDENS

The gardens take centre stage here. From ornamental to productive, they provide inspiration and sustenance for body and mind, supplying all eateries with herbs, flowers, fruit, vegetables and honey. Woodland provides logs for structures, compost for the ornamental gardens, and leaves and berries for the kitchens.

Each area of the garden has been meticulously researched to bring the estate's past to life, and tell a story of gardening through the ages. Guests are led on a journey through various historical phases - from a Roman Villa garden to a Victorian fragrance garden.

At their core lies a Parabola walled garden with a comprehensive national collection of trained apple trees of more than 300 varieties. Apple cultivars that come from England are arranged in a maze, by order of county.

Beezantium



Helicopter landings are available on request.


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
