## Connect

#### **Murmuration**

Starling murmurations are a true wonder of the natural world and the Avalon Marshes host this amazing wildlife spectacle every year. The starlings leave the marshes during the day and go off to feed, some up to 20 miles away. They return in the afternoon and the murmurations can start an hour or so before sunset.

Location: Ham Wall - 35 minutes by car Best time: just before sunset



#### Stonehenge

A private tour of the World Heritage prehistoric monument on Salisbury Plain in Wiltshire, two miles west of Amesbury. It consists of an outer ring of vertical sarsen standing stones, each around 13 feet high, seven feet wide, and weighing around 25 tons, topped by connecting horizontal lintel stones. <u>Stonehenge</u>

Location: Salisbury - 40 minutes by car Time: 09:30 – 17:00 – advanced tickets advised

### **Stourhead House and Gardens**

World-famous landscape gardens with a lake set among lawns and classical temples, surrounded by trees and with sweeping views. One of the first grand Palladian-style villas to be built in England.

#### Longleat

In 1949, Longleat House became the first privately owned stately home to open to the public commercially. But its history extends much further back. Built between 1567 and 1580, it has been lived in by sixteen generations of the Thynn family. Today it is the family home of the 8th Marquess and Marchioness of Bath. ### **City of Bath**

Take a tour through time and explore the only UK city designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You'll travel centuries in just a few steps. Visit the Roman Baths dating back to AD43 to see how our former settlers liked to unwind. Wander through the pages of one of Austen's classic novels as you stroll past mellow architectural masterpieces like the Royal Crescent and the Circus, or celebrate Bath's most famous resident at the Jane Austen Centre.

#### Glastonbury

A spiritual magnet for centuries for both pagan and Christians, this National Trust site is worth a visit. Glastonbury Tor is a hill near Glastonbury in the English county of Somerset, topped by the roofless St Michael's Tower, a Grade I listed building.

### Hauser & Wirth, Gallery

Private tours of the gallery by inhouse Art director, who will lead you through the current exhibition. Guests may also wish to enjoy a post viewing lunch at Roth Bar & Grill <u>Roth Bar & Grill.</u> Occupying a former farmstead in Bruton, Hauser & Wirth Somerset is home to a vibrant program of art exhibitions, events, learning activities and artists' residencies, which connect with the local community and landscape. The Gardens are a delight too, a planting installation by garden designer Piet Oudolf called the Oudolf Field.

#### **Messums Museum**

Messums Wiltshire is a pioneering multi-purpose gallery and arts centre celebrating the creative endeavour. Opened in Autumn 2016 after a two-year restoration project to bring a thirteenth century tithe barn, the largest thatched building in the country, back to life as an exhibition and event space.
